



STATEMENT FROM THE DALLAS MUSEUM OF ILLUSIONS REGARDING COVID-19

To Whom It May Concern:

The Dallas Museum of Illusions is closely monitoring the evolving situation regarding the new coronavirus (COVID-19) and following the recommendations and guidelines of health officials, with the health and well-being of our community in mind.

As you likely know, there are now multiple confirmed cases of COVID-19, more commonly known as “coronavirus,” among the residents of the DFW Metroplex.

The Museum’s absolute highest priority is the health and safety of our guests as well as our staff. We are taking every necessary precaution to prevent, manage, and mitigate the possibility of the virus spreading. Accordingly, we are implementing additional health and safety precautions to maintain the cleanliness of our museum, including increasing our sanitation efforts on all surfaces in high traffic areas. Sanitizer Dispensers are also available throughout the museum for all visitors and staff.

At this time, The Dallas Museum of Illusions intends to remain open with our regular operating hours. In an effort to protect our staff and our guests, we have reduced the amount of tickets available per hour so that our guests are more comfortable in the museum and to allow for less crowding.

Please remember to take care of yourself. Although we have sanitizing stations, please understand that washing your hands frequently with soap for at least 20 seconds is the most effective way of keeping germs off of your hands. Also please remember to cover your cough/sneeze with your elbow or sleeve and avoid touching your face. Also, if you are feeling ill, please stay home.
